## 2005-2006 : label, certification, approval...



*This time last year, we promised you our "info letter" would not be a "one-shot". So here is letter N° 2! This new info letter is an opportunity to outline our organisation's structure, and to inform you of several official approvals assigned last year to ZOOPÔLE développement and its departments.*

ZOOPÔLE développement is an organisation with an associative (private) status. Administered by a Board, it retains about thirty employees, distributed between different departments:

- > **CTPA\*** (7 persons), in charge of service delivery (mainly field trials) for societies related to animal health and food,
- > **ISPAIA\*** (8 persons), specialised in education, Quality Assurance and consultancy,
- > **IDT\*** (5 persons), which promotes innovation and assists in the creation of small and medium enterprises,
- > **the Information and Documentation department** (1 person)
- > **the General Management and Administration department** (5 persons), also in charge of the Zoopôle promotion.

ZOOPÔLE développement also has a wholly owned subsidiary, named VETRIAL, with a private status (commercial partnership), in charge of the distribution of veterinary drugs for clinical trials.

Within this organisation, CTPA has a wide autonomy, both for organisational and financial aspects, with of course, the strictest contracts confidentiality.

At the end of 2005, the whole associative structure ZOOPÔLE développement was awarded a governmental quality label, and is now designated as a « Centre de Ressources Technologiques Qualifié – Qualified Technological Resource Centre ». Our organisation is the first one to receive this official label in the animal health and production area, recognising our service and management quality. However, before this achievement, ZOOPÔLE développement and VETRIAL had already obtained several approvals:

- > the approval for the Tax Credit for Research, given since 1993 by the Research Ministry and renewed in 2004 for the whole structure,
- > the approval as « Pharmaceutical Establishment Distributing Veterinary Drugs for Clinical Trials » given since 2003 by AFFSA (French Food Security Agency) to VETRIAL,
- > the professional certification OPQF (Professional Qualification Office for Education Organisms), attributed since 2005 to ZOOPÔLE développement for the ISPAIA Department activities.

We are proud of these quality labels, which demonstrate our competence, professionalism and vitality. We hope you will have the opportunity to take advantage of them in 2006!
